

## **PIE A PRESIDENT**

To kick off Relay for Life, All-Greek Council hosted a virtual Pie a President fundraising event. Our eleven chapters were challenged to raise \$100 in 24 hours-any chapter who completed the challenge had the privilege of seeing their chapter president being pied via Instagram Live.

Delta Zeta raised twice the challenge amount and pied their president, Beth Jessee, as well as their Relay for Life Team Captain, Veronica McDade. Alpha Sigma Tau, Theta Xi, Sigma Sigma Sigma, and Lambda Chi Alpha also completed the challenge, resulting in their respective presidents being pied.

The Pie a President event raised \$749 in 24 hours for Relay for Life, and we'd like to thank not only our chapter members for advocating and boosting the fundraiser but also any donors to our teams' Relay for Life pages!

## **FUNDRAISING TOTAL**

As of April 5, our eleven chapters had raised \$6,150 toward Relay for Life. Because of COVID-19 and remote learning, the inperson Relay for Life event was converted to an all-month virtual event. By the end of April, our chapters raised \$6,989–59% of the total contribution to the University-wide event.
